The Board of Trustees of the Association for the Advancement of Psychology (AAP) is pleased to honor the plaintiffs and the California Association of Psychology Providers (CAPP) for their historic role in the recent litigation widely known as CAPP v. Rank.

CAPP's initiation and prosecution of this lengthy and difficult litigation culminating in the establishment by the California Supreme Court of psychologists' right to function autonomously in inpatient settings, not only established an important legal precedent, but is a historic milestone in the development of professional psychological practice.

The willingness of the plaintiffs and CAPP to endure the vicissitudes of the extended legal proceedings represents an unusual and very important form of advocacy for psychology.
